Parnassos Ski Centre

Parnassos Ski Centre is only 17 km away from Amfikleia. It is the largest and most well-organised ski centre in the country, with facilities in Kelaria and Fterolaka. The chalet in Fterolaka has recently been renovated.

It offers 19 ski runs, 7 ski trails, 8 connecting trails and 3 beginner mini ski runs with baby-lifts, covering a length of 36 km.

Downhill ski runs begin at an altitude of 2,260m and descend to 1,640m. Their individual length ranges from 300m to 4km and covers all levels of difficulty and skill.


Four of the ski runs, Vackhos (2), Iniochos (6), Heracles (8) and Odysseas (9) are certified by the International Ski Federation for the organization of international ski competitions.


Parnassos ski Centre also organizes night skiing events.

At the Ski Centre, there are two café-chalets and a restaurant, ski and snowboarding schools, ski and snowboard equipment rental shops and a playground service for the little ones.

Within the boundaries of the Ski Centre, there are 4 mountain biking trails (downhill, free ride & cross country).

Municipal Unit of Tithorea

Overlooking the fertile plains, Kato Tithorea, the administrative centre of the Municipality of Amfikleia – Elateia, enjoys all the conveniences of an urban settlement, under the watchful eye of Mt Parnassos. The square is an oasis of greenery and the centre of the locals' life. It is especially charming during Christmas, when it transforms into a Christmas Wonderland. Here stands the bust of the "father" of Greek Cinematography, Philopimin Finos. His birthplace pays tribute to him every July, by organizing various cultural events and needless to say, lots of film projections!

The village of Agia Marina is perched on the foothills of north Parnassos, at an altitude of 350 metres. At the courtyard of its church, there is an immense plane tree that has been desognated as a traditional natural element. Drive towards the inner part of Parnassos and witness its wild beauty from a perspective no other trail up the mountain offers. The Monastery of the Assumption of Virgin Mary, an imposing fortress whose history is lost in the depths of the ages, will suddenly reveal itself. Outside its walls, you can taste the crystal clear water of Mt Parnassos that flows from the stone-built well.

Agia Paraskevi is one of the smallest villages of Amfikleia - Elateia and it is located by the frontier of the County of Viotia. Enjoy a relaxing walk at the grove that surrounds the village and at Kifisos River with its stone-built bridge, while Mt Parnassos guides your way.

On the foothills of Mt Kallidromo, Modi stands out for its traditional architecture. On the outskirts of the village, there is the post-byzantine chapel of the Transfiguration of Christ, which was constructed in 1571 and has been listed as a historic heritage monument. Other sights of great interest are the Ancient Quarry, a monument of ancient construction and mining technology, and Modi Hill at Pyrgos, where the walls of a Hellenistic ancient city have been

Tithorea was first populated in 2000 BC and its name derives from a toponym of Parnassos. It is enchanting as it is built at an altitude of 450 metres on the foothills of eastern Parnassos, where an impressive rock hangs on top of the house rooftops which extend to the opening of the Kahala gorge, defining not only the wild beauty of the mountain, but also the wisdom of our ancient ancestors who chose this ideal location-natural fortress. There are many sights to visit: The ancient walls of the Hellenistic period (323-30 B.C.), the Balcony or Plakoto of Tithorea, the century-old plane tree of 1887 at the square, the aesthetic forest of Tithorea (Natura 2000), the Kahala gorge, the Trypi waterfall, the impressive cave -hideout of Odysseas Androutsos.



Nature | Trails | Routes

The rich natural landscape that lies within the geographical boundaries of the Municipality of Amfikleia - Elateia is a serendipity for its inhabitants and a challenge for its visitors. The imposing Mt Parnassos (Liakoura peak 2,457m), with its diverse geomorphology, satisfies even the most demanding mountaineer. Gorges, steep slopes, snow-covered peaks, waterfalls and crystal clear plunge pools form unique images, especially in the southwestern part of the Municipality, which includes Parnassos National Forest.

Mt Kallidromo (Gioza peak 1,419m), opposite Parnassos, is one of the most beautiful mountains of Mainland Greece, with mild terrain and many plateaus where seasonal lakes are formed. Indicatively, we mention Lake Nevropolis, an alluring location that has been listed as Landscape of Outstanding Natural Beauty. It is easy to hike – as its name indicates – therefore, it is ideal for children too. As regards mountain biking, choices are infinite!

Recommended routes: 1. Tithorea - Androutsos Cave/2. Amfikleia - Hagiarsali

1. The trail with a view to the Kahala Gorge begins at Platanakos, next to the bust of Odysseas Androutsos. During spring and winter, you can admire the waterfalls, whose rapids fall from a height of 30 metres or more. On the way, you will come across the chapel of St George, which is surrounded by huge oak trees. However, when you set eyes on the gigantic cave of Odysseas Androutsos which nests 20 metres above ground, you will make sense of the real hideout and the greatness of man! Dyseas Cave or Black Hole, as it was called at the time, was his last hideout until his death in 1825.

Level of difficulty: Fairly easy/ Duration: 1h30mins

2. A very steep path among fir trees begins at Amfikleia and the nearby Gorge of Varsamo and leads to the chapel of Hagiarsali, after about an hour. Hagiarsali is a corruption of the name Hagia Ierousalim (St. Jerousalem), which is celebrated the second day of Easter. The faith of the people who built it in the outermost part of the area and carved it into a vertical rock is awe-inspiring. Its balcony gazes into the vastness and we would urge you to go on this journey with limited company, so as to feel the sacred tranquility of the mountain.

Level of difficulty: Moderate / Duration: 1 hour

Municipal Unit of Amfikleia

In Antiquity, it was called Ophiteia and later on Amfikaia. Amfikleia is the largest settlement of the Municipality and it ideally balances the variety of services a small town offers with the preserved traditions of a village, which are reflected in architecture and folklore. Visit the only Bread Museum in Greece and the Craftmanship Museum at the plane-tree-covered central square. Stroll around the upper part of town and get enchanted. Around the stone-built well of Choreftaria, the splendor of the past unfolds, which officially designated Amfikleia as a Traditional Settlement. Amfikleia is only 17 km away from Parnassos Ski Centre. An ideal destination!

In Antiquity, most of the settlements of the area were destroyed by Xerxes, therefore, strong fortification walls were built around them later on (5th century B.C.). The most well-preserved of all stands at the entrance of renowned Drymaia. As you walk to the top of the hill, picture the walls that stopped at the banks of River Kifisos and continued across, climbing up the backbone of Mt Parnassos to fortify another settlement. Feel the awe of history! Do not skip the visit to Drymaia and the chapel of St George, which seems miniature next to the centuries-old towering oak trees.

Have a unique experience at Bralos while you visit its magnificent folklore museum, founded by "Kipseli", the Progressive Women's Association of Bralos. The splendid "Tsipouro Festival", organized by the Cultural Association of Bralos, is held in November, when the alluring surrounding nature of the village dresses in the colors of autumn. Witness the distillation process, taste delicious dishes accompanied by tsipouro and enjoy the dance groups honoring Roumeli in one

Xilikoi, located among lush vegetation and running water on the slope (600m) of Kallidromo, is revealed to the public during the celebrations of St Paraskevi, on the 26th of July. During the emblematic folkloric festival, the visitor initially browses through writings about the history of the wider area at the book fair, then enjoys the folkloric dance groups and finally participates actively in the revels, the way they do in Roumeli. The shepherds offer the first prize in the lottery,

The beautiful Paleochori Dorieon, built on Mt Kallidromo at an altitude of 500 meters, gazes across the mountains of Parnassos, Giona and Vardousia. In Antiquity, Kitinion was located here, which formed part of the Doric Tetrapolis that was constructed during the descent of the Dorians. Due to its abundant nature, it is an ideal gateway to the mountain, and Lake Nevropolis (Nevros: deer) of Kallidromo, a plateau of unparalleled beauty, surrounded by plane trees and rare wildflowers. It is a lifetime experience one should not miss!

Tithronio offers an unobstructed view to the meadow of Kifisos and the mountains of Roumeli, while at the stone-built square, visitors can share some of the locals' privileges. According to Pausanias, Ancient Tithronio was 15 stadiums away from Amfikleia and 20 stadiums away from Drymaia and it had a temple that was dedicated to Apollo and an oracle of Dionysus. The archaeological site of Palaiocastro is where Odysseas Androutsos found shelter after the battle of



Folklore | Tradition

In this land, the heart of tradition beats all year round and the preservation of the folk culture and customs of Roumeli is expressed through a wide range of events. The following indicative suggestions are a good place to start. Visit:

▶ Amfikleia during the carnival, where celebrations include Dionysian customs, bells, maypole dance, a huge bonfire (chei) and a 130-metre kontosouvli, the largest in the world.

▶ Kato Tithorea during the Carnival, where the custom of the *mutton in the* cauldron is held. It is cooked with pasta and accompanied with lots of revels

▶ **Tithorea**, on Ash Monday, where the customs of the Vlach wedding and the preparation of the traditional bean soup are revived.

▶ The villages at Easter that get festive, along with nature. In every neighborhood, you will come across the traditional pits where lamp is roasted.

▶ Amfikleia on the 21st of November, where a three-day bread festival takes

▶ Kato Tithorea and its wonderful Santa's village at Christmas.

▶ Elateia, on the 2nd of January, where the Local Youth Association cuts the largest Vasilopita (New Year's cake).!



Municipal Unit of Elateia

Elateia was the second most important city, after Delphi, during the Hellenistic and Roman times. The prominent temple of Kranaia Athenea stood at the foothills of Mt Kallidromo. Get familiar with the glorious past of the region by visiting the rich Archaeological Collection, which includes many important findings of West Lokrida – northeastern Fokida in Antiquity – that date back to the Paleolithic period. The presentation of the exhibits is extraordinary, as the visitor gets in direct contact with the artifacts in their functional space: earthenware, tools, figurines, jewellery. In consultation with the Municipality, you can plan a visit to the remarkable Mycenaean Chamber Tombs.

Zeli is the only mountainous village (500m) in the Municipal Unit of Elateia. Enjoy a cup of coffee at the beautiful square with a view to the mountains and don't miss out on the impressive Monastery of Prophet Elias that was erected during the Frankish rule, and the Holy Church of Osios Seraphim, where parts of the Saint's Holy Relics are kept.

In **Leukochori**, the visitor can stroll around and admire the well-preserved stone-built buildings of the traditional architecture of the early 20th century. Take a walk to Alisaki to pay tribute to the Memorial of the Fallen of 1821 and then rest at the big square with the mulberry trees opposite the imposing church of St George.

Panagitsa is a lowland village of Kifisos, whose intense marks of the past are reflected in the well-preserved mud-brick houses. It's adjacent to the plane tree forest, a remarkable attraction and an oasis of freshness.

The extensive cultivation of the fields marks the entrance of the village of **Sfaka** on Mt Sfiggio. Around the church of St Demetrious, which dates back to 1830, this peaceful village looks like theatrical scenery, where the leading actors take their daily seats at the old coffee shops.
